Importation of Diagnostic Specimens

The CDC Detroit Quarantine Station recommends that importers of non-infectious biological specimens apply for a CDC Etiologic Agent Import Permit to expedite the clearance of shipments into the U.S. The application for the permit can be found here: http://www.cdc.gov/od/caipp/. The permit will allow the importation of multiple shipments of non-infectious biological specimens into the U.S. designated as "Approved for Diagnostic Purposes Only". The permit should be included with every shipment of biological specimens.

If an importer does not intend to import multiple shipments of biological specimens into the U.S, the shipment must be accompanied by a signed statement, on official letterhead, from the person responsible for the shipment of the material. If this letter was not included with the shipment it must be faxed or emailed to the CDC Detroit Quarantine Station (see contact information below). The letter should contain the following elements:

- ✓ A description of the material,
- ✓ A statement indicating that "this material is not known or suspected to contain an etiological agent, host, or vector of human disease."

Please fax or email the required statement to the CDC Detroit Quarantine Station to obtain CDC clearance.
