To whom it may concern,

Florida made changes to health care licensure laws within the State, including the repeal of the Agency's authority to license Clinical Laboratories effective July 1, 2018. Providers who perform clinical laboratory testing must continue to obtain and maintain federal certification from the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) program and, when applicable, comply with clinical laboratory personnel licensure requirements.
